- **The ticket cutoff date has been extended through Sunday, July 1.**
- Cost: \$23.00 per person. Ages 3-10: \$18.00 per person. Ages 2 & Under: FREE.
- What does this price include? Your game ticket plus an all-you-can-eat picnic buffet with hamburgers, brats, hot dogs, chips, baked beans and 2 drink tickets (beer, soda or water). Gates open and the picnic starts 30 minutes before the game and food is available for 1½ hours.

- Seating: Picnic tables with umbrellas. You can also carry-in your own umbrellas, blankets and attachable stadium chairs.
