6th Grade Immunizations: The Wisconsin Student Immunization Law requires that all students entering 6th grade receive a dose of Tdap (Tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis) vaccine. Please have your child immunized well in advance of school starting, as it is often difficult to get clinic appointments if you wait until late summer. Call

your provider, or the Fond du Lac County Health Department (929-3085) to check your child's immunization records.

Hot Lunch Accounts: As you plan payments for the remainder of the year, take note that after today there are 5 days of school remaining. Please make sure your child's hot lunch account will cover the remaining lunches. That amount would be \$13.75 for all 5 meals, \$11 for 4, and \$8.25 for 3. Don't forget to take into account the days in which your child might be gone for a class trip. Negative balances need to be taken care of by the last day of school. Positive balances can be carried over to next year. It would be appreciated if the carry-over amount would be as little as possible. If you have a positive balance and would like a refund, please let Mrs. Koepsell know. She will be available after the closing service to take care of any positive or negative balances.

Extended Care Accounts & Electronic Key Cards: Mrs. Runge will be available in the cafeteria both before and after the closing service on Thursday evening, May 23 to settle any bills for the extended care program. She will also be able to take care of returning deposits for key cards at that same time. You have the option to hang on to the card if you are returning next year and we will continue to hold onto your deposit.

End of the Year Picnic: Our end of the year picnic has been cancelled due to the weather forecasted for Saturday. Please join us this summer for our two Family Nights on Sunday, June 23 and July 28 from 5:00-7:00pm. We will have a group game beginning at 5:00, cookout at 6:00 (hot dogs will be provided, just bring a side dish or dessert to pass) and we will finish with songs and devotion around 6:30.
