2019-20 Enrollment: Please take note of the enrollment email that you received from TADS for next school year. We have open enrollment for returning students until May 15. If you have multiple children you will need to enroll them all and then you can continue onto the financial agreement.

Tuition Assistance 2019-20: Tuition assistance forms for the coming school year are available in the office. Please do NOT use the online form listed on TADS – use the paper forms in the office. The forms should be handed in by **May 15.**

Church & School Connection Letter: Our school board and church council, along with the board of elders, has been working on a policy for our school and church attendance during the past year. A letter is attached to today's newsletter which details the policy they have initiated that will go into effect for the 2020-21 school year.

Next fall, we will host an open forum to discuss the connection between our congregational membership and school tuition and how this will work with the policy in the following school year.

6th Grade Immunizations: The Wisconsin Student Immunization Law requires that all students entering 6th grade receive a dose of Tdap (Tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis) vaccine. Please have your child immunized well in advance of school starting, as it is often difficult to get clinic appointments if you wait until late summer. Call your provider, or the Fond du Lac County Health Department (929-3085) to check your child's immunization records.
