REMINDER

2019-20 Enrollment: Please take the time to enroll your child through TADS, it only takes a few minutes. If your child is not coming back, please let us know. Also, the financial agreement needs to be completed by July 1st if you have not finished that part already. We have 11 kids who still need to enroll for next year. Thank you to those who have finished the process!

6th Grade Immunizations: The Wisconsin Student Immunization Law requires that all students entering 6th grade receive a dose of Tdap (Tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis) vaccine. Please have your child immunized well in advance of school starting, as it is often difficult to get clinic appointments if you wait until late summer. Call your provider, or the Fond du Lac County Health Department (929-3085) to check your child's immunization records.

Graduation/Closing Service: Our closing service is tomorrow, May 23 at 6:30pm. All children in grades K-8 will be singing for this service. Report cards will be handed out when the service is done. Any unclaimed report cards after that evening will be placed at the front desk for pick-up.

Lost & Found: Please check this over before summer break. Anything left will make its way to the WLA thrift store over summer.

Field Day: Tomorrow, for the last day of school, we will be having our traditional Field Day. All students will be formed into teams mixed with K-8 students and compete in a series of events.

Hot Lunch Accounts: A reminder that **all negative hot lunch balances need to be taken care of by the closing service.** Positive balances can be carried over to next year. It would be appreciated if the carry-over amount would be as little as possible. If you have a positive balance and would like a refund, please let Mrs. Koepsell know. She will be available before and after the closing service to take care of any positive or negative balances. Thank you.

Extended Care Accounts & Electronic Key Cards: Mrs. Runge will be available in the cafeteria both before and after the closing service on Thursday evening, May 23 to settle any bills for the extended care program. She will also be able to take care of returning deposits for key cards at that same time. You have the option to hang on to the card if you are returning next year and we will continue to hold onto your deposit.
