SECOND LESSON

Revelation 3:14-22

More valuable than worldly wealth are the spiritual and eternal treasures that our Savior provides for us.

¹⁴To the messenger of the church in Laodicea write: The Amen, the faithful and true witness, the ruler of God's creation, says this: ¹⁵I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. If only you were cold or hot! ¹⁶So, because you are lukewarm and not hot or cold, I am about to spit you out of my mouth. ¹⁷You say, "I am rich. I have become very wealthy and need nothing." But you do not know that you are miserable, pitiful, poor, blind, and naked. ¹⁸I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich, and white garments, so that you may be clothed and the shame of your nakedness may not become public, and salve to anoint your eyes, so that you may see. ¹⁹I rebuke and discipline those whom I love. So take this seriously and repent. ²⁰Look, I stand at the door and I am knocking. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will go in with him and dine with him, and he with

me. ²¹To the one who is victorious I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I was victorious and sat down with my Father on his throne. ²²Whoever has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

GOSPEL

John 14:23-29

The fear and trepidation that can arise in our hearts are replaced with the loving Presence of our indwelling God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

²³Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will hold on to my word. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. ²⁴The one who does not love me does not hold on to my words. The word that you are hearing is not mine, but it is from the Father who sent me. ²⁵"I have told you these things while staying with you. ²⁶But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I told you.

²⁷"Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, and do not let it be afraid. ²⁸You heard me tell you, 'I am going away and I am coming to you.' If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, because the Father is greater than I. ²⁹"I have told you now before it happens so that, when it does happen, you may believe."
