

- Date: **Tuesday, July 30, 2019**. First pitch: 6:35 pm.
- Ticket cutoff date is **Sunday, July 14**, unless the 125 maximum is reached before this date.
- Cost: \$26.00 per person. Ages 3-10: \$21.00 per person. Ages 2 & Under: FREE.
- What does this price include? Your game ticket plus an all-you-can-eat picnic buffet with hamburgers, brats, hot dogs, chips, baked beans and 2 drink tickets (beer, soda or water).
- Gates open at 5:35 pm. The picnic starts 30 minutes before the game at 6:05 pm and the food is available for 1 ½ hours.
- Corn Hole, Ping-Pong & Giant Connect 4 can also be played in the grassy area.
- Seating: Picnic tables with umbrellas. You can also carry-in your own umbrellas, blankets and attachable stadium chairs.
- Sign-up sheets and additional details are posted in the narthex, along with payment envelopes and a collection box.
