Our Bible Lesson

In our Bible lesson we learned about “Building the Tabernacle.” That is found in Exodus 34-40, especially 35:4-9, 20-29 and 36:2-7. We compared St. Peter’s Church to the Tabernacle from long ago. We saw that there are similarities and differences. We took a tour of the church to see the piano, organ, as well as all of the big pipes, and where the choir sings. We looked at the church windows including many of Jesus and one of Martin Luther, Jesus on the cross in the front of church above the beautifully carved Lord’s Supper on the altar, and the baptismal font.

We will be singing the first verse of the hymns that the older children sing in chapel. This week we’ve been singing “Hark, the Voice of Jesus

Crying” so that we’ll be familiar with it when we attend chapel.

Musical Theme

We use music throughout the morning every day!

We sing : when picking up toys
to find our carpet space
at the end of Bible lesson
before going outside
to line up
to say good-bye

After snack every day we look at books while listening to quiet music. After books we move in some way on the carpet, often to music. This week we have been dancing fast, slow, and then freezing when the music stops. In gym: we moved with scarves to music marched and played instruments to marching music.

This week we used Sing and Make Music:

#1 The Voice - We used our voices in many ways: singing, speaking, shouting, and whispering

#2 Dynamics - comparing loud and soft

For story time Mrs. Westphal: sang the story Sing

read Music in the Air which shows where music can be heard and Music and Art which told us all about instruments.

4K Reading Readiness

We used a CD and our storybooks to practice following directions.

Activity boards were used to match items to the correct bears.

Unit 2 was finished and is coming home.

Our new unit will begin with the big book La Tortuga which means “The Turtle” in Spanish.

3K Numbers

We acted out “Six Little Ducks” and practiced #6 with our finger pencils and Do-a-dots.
