## PRESCHOOL HAPPENINGS

### God's Word

Our Bible lesson is taken from the second book of the Bible, Exodus. It's found in Exodus 19:2, 16-19, 20:1-17, and 32:15-16. The title is "The Giving of the Law." In the Ten Commandments God gave us a set of rules to obey. We try to obey these laws to show our love for Jesus, but we need his help every step of the way. He first loved us by dying on the cross to forgive all of

our sins. God gave us the law through his servant, Moses.

### Outside Time

Red Light, Green Light - The children run when seeing the green stoplight. They stop when the red light is shown.

Practicing Movement - We jump, hop, gallop, etc. often.

Playground Equipment - The children like to play with balls and hoops.

### Math Concepts

Boxes of various sizes and shapes were explored by sorting, building and fitting them inside each other.

3K and 4K became familiar with Unifix cubes exploring and making things with them.

### Pumpkins

Dora's Perfect Pumpkin, Pumpkin Patch Blessings, and The Pumpkin Patch Parable were enjoyed.

"The Five Little Pumpkins" song was learned.

On Friday, 4K will decorate small, construction paper pumpkins with stems and a variety of materials: buttons, googly eyes, pom poms, pipe cleaners, and foam shapes.

### Reading Readiness in 4K

We learn as we: Listen to sounds.

Draw lines across and under.

Use sizes, red and blue.

Match pictures.

Cut, sort, and glue pictures.

### 3K's Fun with Numbers

We use finger pencils and Do-a-dots for the numbers 1-5. We listen to Five Green and Speckled Frogs and Five Little Ducks using song with books.
