Weekly Bible Lesson

Our weekly Bible lesson comes from Daniel 6. What an example Daniel was for us! He was commanded to pray only to the king for 30 days. Before that time he prayed to God 3 times a day. Spatial Concepts

In gym: We circled to the left, right, in, out,

etc. to music.

We moved a ball over our heads and under our bodies.

In art: Left and Right Art - On the right half of our papers we painted with our right hands and on the

left half of our papers we painted with our left hands. It looks different!

With books and cards: We looked at a variety of pictures on spatial cards using words to describe them.

Action opposites were acted out with the book Red Light, Green Light.

Some fun spatial books were read such as <u>Hop on</u> <u>Pop</u>, <u>There's a Wocket in my Pocket</u>, and <u>Let's</u> <u>Play</u> in which we followed a yellow ball throughout the book.

Math

We became familiar with collections by exploring, describing, arranging and sorting the items in various ways.

4K Reading Readiness

Concept Development: green, top, middle, bottom; parts of a whole

The Storybook: The Elves and the Shoemaker Letters: Recognize, name identify and circle the letters G and H. With each new letter we get to pick out a new stuffed animal to play with for a few weeks during center and quiet reading time.

3K Numbers

We focused on the numbers 8 & 9. We counted 8 and 9 shapes, drew with finger pencils, and used the poem "Pit-a-Pat" to count raindrops on our hats. Our favorite Do-a-dots were used for number 9.
