*Jesus Heals*

Our Bible lesson was “Jesus Heals the Paralyzed Man.” The students pretended to be paralyzed men not moving until at the end when they could jump for joy, because Jesus healed their bodies and their souls, by forgiving their sins. The lesson comes from Mark 2:1-12 and Luke 4:17-26.

*Music*

Our theme was music. The children:

- \* sang Psalm 100:1 – “Oh make a joyful noise unto the Lord!”
- \* moved to music with scarves.
- \* followed aerobic moves to music.
- \* learned songs from a Music and Movement presentation. Some action songs were “Come on , Everyone”, “Clap Your Hands” and “Snowflakes”.
- \* sang and spelled out B-I-N-G-O from Sing and Make Music.
- \* learned about instruments from A Child’s First Library of Learning Music and Art.
