There is an option for half days. There will be twelve spots open for full days (\$3000 per year) and twelve for half days (\$1500 per year). Real Love

Valentine Activities

We played some Valentine games in the gym while singing Valentine songs. Valentines were distributed in Valentine bags (4K) and pails (3K.) We used cookie cutter hearts and crosses with paint on paper and a poster to remind everyone as they pass in the hallway how much Jesus loves them. God's Great Love for You, Jesus loves Children, and the hearts on our wall reinforced God's love.

4K Reading Readiness
