May you hear once again the Biblical accounts of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, Jesus' crucifixion on Good Friday, and the good news of the empty tomb on Easter Sunday. What a privilege to worship together!

### *The Saddest Day, The Happiest Day*

We studied "Jesus is Crucified" from Matthew 27:32-66 and Luke 23:35-56. The sadness of Jesus' death, but also the joy of our Savior's love and forgiveness was portrayed.

We've been singing an alphabet song about Jesus' death for us, his word of truth, and a home for us eternally in heaven.
