Jesus in the Garden

Our Bible lesson was "Jesus in Gethsemane." The children marveled at the beautiful church window in St. Peter's that shows this Bible lesson. They acted out Jesus and his disciples in the garden from Matthew 26:36-56. They pretended that they were the disciples who kept falling asleep instead of watching and praying with Jesus.

For 12 school days we are opening colorful Easter eggs to find an item connected to Christ's Passion. We have found a donkey, silver coins, and praying hands.

We continued our Bible passages that go with each letter of the alphabet. In 4K reading readiness we are learning the letters Oo, Pp, and Qq right now. One of our current Bible passages is: *I will praise the LORD all my life; I will sing praise to my God as long as I live.* Psalm 146:2

Spring Is Here!

We are so happy to be celebrating the arrival of spring, especially this year!

During gym/outside time:

*Cones were used to represent trees in an obstacle course.

*We pantomimed activities in each season.

*Hula Hoop Hopscotch was played.

At quiet reading time:

*We listened to "Songbirds at Sunrise" which has North American bird songs amidst the music.

*Spring, the seasons, and Lenten books were made available.

*Lenten cards could be matched.

During art class:

*Mosaic crosses were made.

*We drew our families enjoying a springtime day outside. Seeds were added to our flowers for a 3D effect.

At story time we listened to:

*When Will It Be Spring? about a baby bear who continually wakes up wondering if spring has come.

*Spring Changes showing how God introduces spring each year with buds on the trees, birds returning, and animals awakening from their winter sleep.

*My Book of Seasons shows how spring begins, God then sends the summer, fall, and winter only to return to spring. He is always in control.

*Lesson 8: Long items were underlined. Squares and rectangles were identified and colored.

*Lesson 9: Each child shared his/her favorite part of The City Mouse and the Country Mouse. Directions were followed and papers were marked.
