**REMINDER** **Registration 2021-2022:** We have open enrollment for returning students until May 15. Each family should have received a link from TADS to begin registration for the 2021-22 school year. The updated supply list for next school year was sent home for when you come to the bookstore items. Please look over all personal information and make changes if need be. If you are not returning, please let us know.

\*\*TADS did add a \$20 fee for one or two installments & \$55 for 3+ installments. There is also an ACH fee of \$1-5 per transaction.

**Tuition Assistance 2021-22:** Tuition assistance forms for the coming school year are available in the office. Please do NOT use the online form listed on TADS – use the paper forms in the office.

**6<sup>th</sup> Grade Immunizations:** The Wisconsin Student Immunization Law requires that all students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade receive a dose of Tdap (Tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis) vaccine. Please have your child immunized well in advance of school starting, as it is often difficult to get clinic appointments if you wait until late summer. Call your provider, or the Fond du Lac County Health Department (929-3085) to check your child's immunization records.
