The World Hears the Truth

Our Bible lesson was "The First Pentecost" from Acts 2. Jesus had ascended into heaven. Ten days later his followers heard a mighty, rushing wind in the house where they were staying. Flames of fire appeared on their heads. These were signs from the Holy Spirit that something important was about to happen. The disciples were able to speak the good news of Jesus in many languages. That day 3,000 people believed and were baptized.

The Five Senses

Gym/Outside Time:

*Bean bags or balls were thrown through the world, the cross, and heart shaped holes in a box. When one made it through, the child told something about God.

*The children moved to instruments. Each instrument had its own movement. For example, the drum beat meant it was time to march.

*We took a "5 Senses Walk" outside seeing, hearing, touching, and smelling. No, not any tasting was done.

With music:

*We listened to a variety of sounds in "Smart Symphonies."

*"My Hand on my Head" listed various body parts in Spanish as we pointed to them and repeated in Spanish.

*"The Five Senses" song was sung. We then saw a picture and had to decide which sense we would use to experience it.

In art:

Various textured materials were glued onto a velvet covered cardboard. Each child picked out his/her choice of materials.

*Here Are My Hands

*Look, Listen, and Learn

*Gilberto and the Wind - The wind is Gilberto's friend. He sees how many things are affected by the blowing wind.
