Registration 2021-2022: Any families on the waiting list for enrollment will be allowed to fill seats for a classroom now. Please take the time to enroll your child through TADS, it only takes a few minutes. If your child is not coming back, please let us know. The **financial agreement needs to be completed by July 1.**

Graduation Service: Our graduation service is tomorrow, May 27 at 6:30pm. Report cards will be handed out in school on the 27th. Any unclaimed report cards after that day will be placed at the front desk for pick-up.

Extended Care Accounts & Electronic Key Cards: Please take care of any remaining balance as soon as possible. Any payments made after school is out may be dropped off in the office. Any remaining credits will carry-over until next year.

If you are not returning next year or if you do not need your key card, you may return it to get your deposit back. Otherwise, you have the option to hang on to the card and we will hold onto your deposit.

Summer Worship Schedule: May 30 is the start of our summer worship schedule (Memorial – Labor Day weekends). Early service will still be held at 7:45am, but late service will begin at 10:00am. Thursday worship remains at 6:30. The school office will be closed Monday, May 31 for Memorial Day.

Yearbook Orders: Unfortunately, our yearbooks are not quite done yet. If you ordered a yearbook it will be put in your church mailbox when they arrive. We will drop the Good Shepherd students' yearbooks off in their mailboxes at Good Shepherd as well. Anyone else who ordered one can pick it up in the school office.
