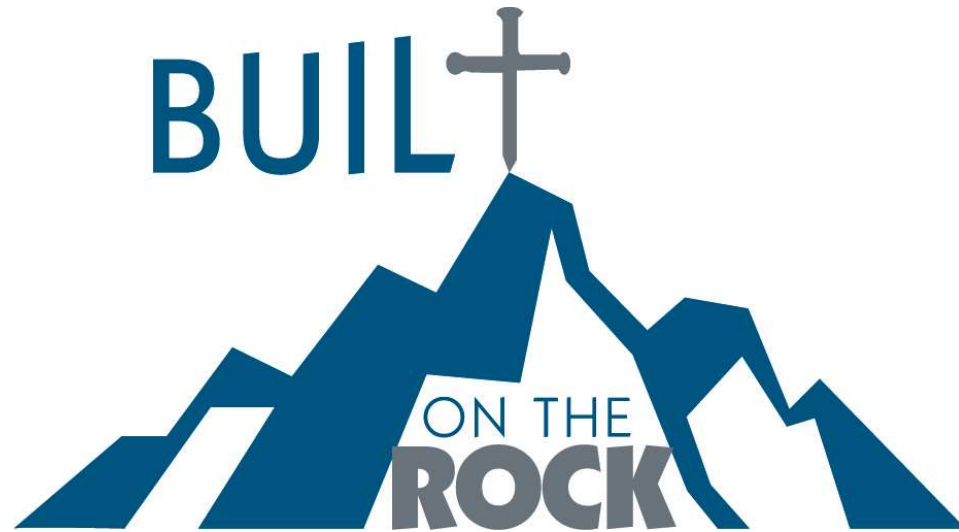

NEW CHRISTIAN WORSHIP HYMNALS God willing we will be able to have the new hymnals in our pews by Advent! It all depends on the generosity of our members whose hearts are warmed by Christ's forgiving love. We already have fifty hymnals that the Choir is becoming familiar with. To fill our sanctuary, we need 550 more hymnals. Along with the accompaniment books for our organists, the Altar Book, and other accompanying publications, the grand total comes to \$15,342 which includes shipping. The *Christian Worship Hymnals* are \$24 each. The new hymnals will broaden our ability during worship to "Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. ²Sing to the LORD, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day."
