Despite rising food costs, supply chain problems, and training a new worker, the program nearly broke even. We are thankful we are now independent because the civil rights statement for federal child nutrition programs is now to include wording that is not in line with Christian doctrine. Thanks to your generosity, \$7440 was awarded in financial aid.
