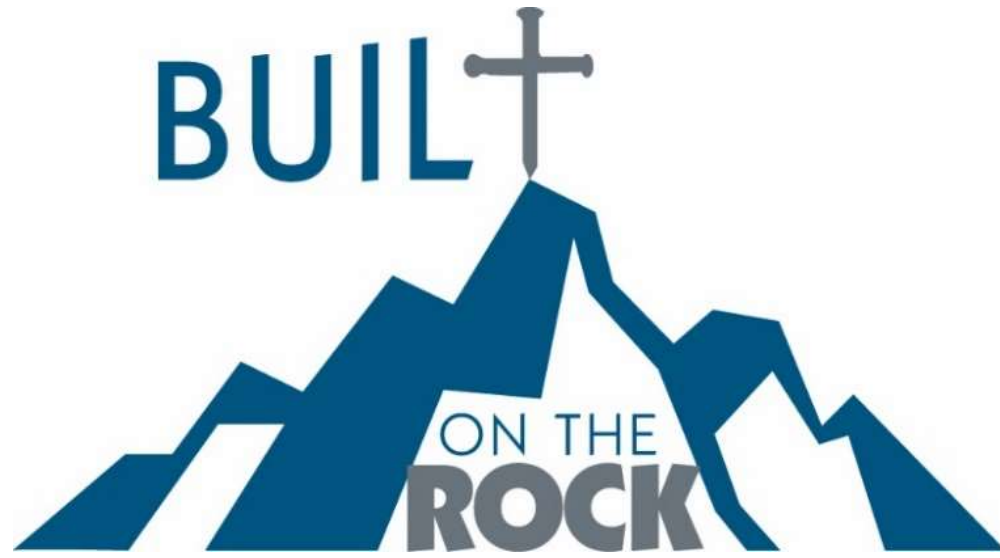

Come and relive World War II via the "internet" of the day – newspapers. This exhibit of newspaper headlines and articles spans the time from December, 1941 to September, 1945. His father is responsible for the vast collection of newspaper headlines, newspaper articles (in some cases whole newspapers), maps and photos (in some cases colored ones). There were over 1300 newspapers during the WW II period. This is living history day-by-day. He even has a short video clip of the Dachau extermination camp. Stuff like this you can not find in any history book!
