FIRST LESSON

Jeremiah 31:15-17

This prophecy speaks of the Jews being taken captive to Babylon and also of Herod's murder of the boys of Bethlehem. Rachel died in childbirth in Bethlehem (Genesis 35).

¹⁵This is what the Lord says.

A voice is heard in Ramah,
weeping and great mourning.
Rachel is weeping for her children.

She refuses to be comforted for her children,
because they are no more.

¹⁶This is what the Lord says.

Stop your crying. Do not shed tears,
because your work will be rewarded, declares the Lord.
They will return from the land of the enemy.

¹⁷There is hope for your future, declares the Lord.
Your children will return to their own borders.

SECOND LESSON

Galatians 4:4-7

Since we have been redeemed by God's true Son, we are now able to call God "Father."

But when the set time had fully come, God sent his Son to be born of a woman, so that he would be born under the law, ⁵in order to redeem those under the law, so that we would be adopted as sons. ⁶And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts to shout, "*Abba, Father!*" ⁷So you are no longer a slave, but a son. And if you are a son, then you are also an heir of God through Christ.

GOSPEL (Sermon Text)

Matthew 2:13-23

God's plan was to save the world by having his true Son serve as our substitute, dying on the cross. And so God saves his true Son from an early death.

After the Wise Men were gone, an angel of the Lord suddenly appeared to Joseph in a dream. He said, "Get up, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, because Herod will search for the child in order to kill him."

¹⁴Joseph got up, took the child and his mother during the night, and left for Egypt. ¹⁵He stayed there until the death of Herod. This happened to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet: "Out of Egypt I called my son."

¹⁶When Herod realized that he had been outwitted by the Wise Men, he was furious. He issued orders to kill all the boys in Bethlehem and in all the surrounding countryside, from two years old and under. This was in keeping with the exact time he had learned from the Wise Men. ¹⁷Then what was spoken through Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled:

¹⁸A voice was heard in Ramah,
weeping and great mourning,
Rachel weeping for her children,
and she refused to be comforted,
because they are no more.

¹⁹After Herod died, an angel of the Lord suddenly appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt. The angel said, ²⁰"Get up, take the child and his mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who were trying to kill the child are dead."

²¹Joseph got up, took the child and his mother, and went to the land of Israel. ²²But when he heard that Archelaus, Herod's son, had succeeded his father as ruler in Judea, he was afraid to go there. Since he had been warned in a dream, he went to the region of Galilee. ²³When he arrived there, he settled in a city called Nazareth. So what was spoken through the prophets was fulfilled: "He will be called a Nazarene."
