New Immunizations Required by State of Wisconsin: The Wisconsin Department of Health Services has alerted all Wisconsin schools to changes in immunization requirements beginning with the 2023-24 school year. The WLA [Immunization Requirements Letter](#) explains the changes in detail (including changes for pre-high school-age children). Changes that affect St. Peter's students include: physician documentation of a child having had chicken pox, a meningitis vaccine for those entering grade 7, and a meningitis booster for those entering grade 12. As always, you have the option to waive any or all immunizations, if so, please fill out a waiver form and return it to the school office.
