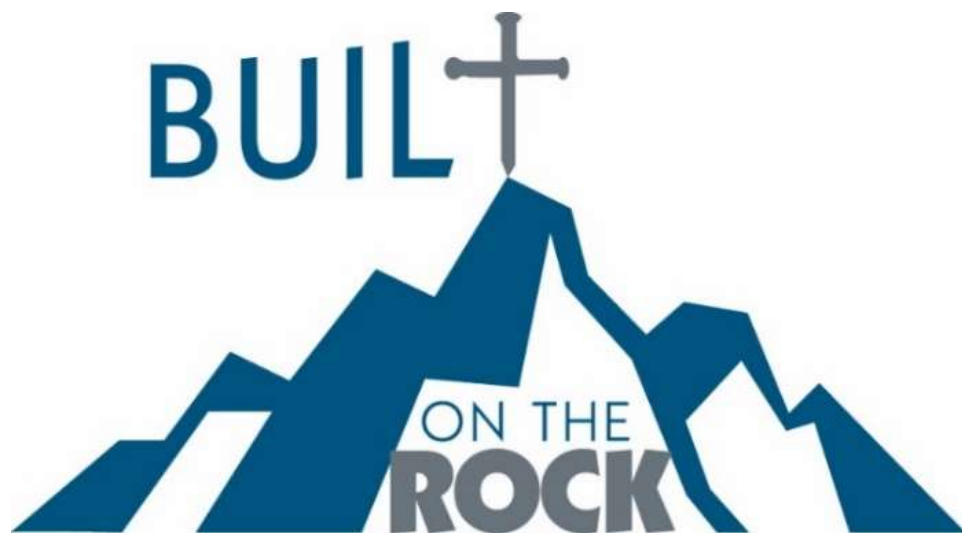

**SCRIP** April 26 is the last day for Scrip purchases to go toward 2023-24 tuition. Scrip credit from purchases after this date will go toward 2024-25 tuition.

**Kohl's is changing** how they handle their scrip cards. Effective June 23, you'll no longer be able to use Kohl's scrip to pay your credit card balance. When WLA/St. Peter's current inventory of Kohl's cards is depleted it will be replaced with new cards, so it's possible this change may happen prior to June 23. The current Kohl's scrip cards may still be used in the store or online. The new cards will have a different design so they'll be easily distinguished from the current cards.
