New Immunizations Required by State of Wisconsin: The Wisconsin Department of

Health Services has alerted all Wisconsin schools to changes in immunization requirements beginning with the 2023-24 school year. Changes that affect St. Peter's students include: physician documentation of a child having had chicken pox and a meningitis vaccine for those entering grade 7. As always, you have the option to waive any or all immunizations, if so, please fill out a waiver form and return it to the school office. Please have your child immunized well in advance of school starting in the fall, as it is often difficult to get clinic appointments if you wait until late summer. Call your provider, or the Fond du Lac County Health Department (929-3085) to check your child's immunization records.
