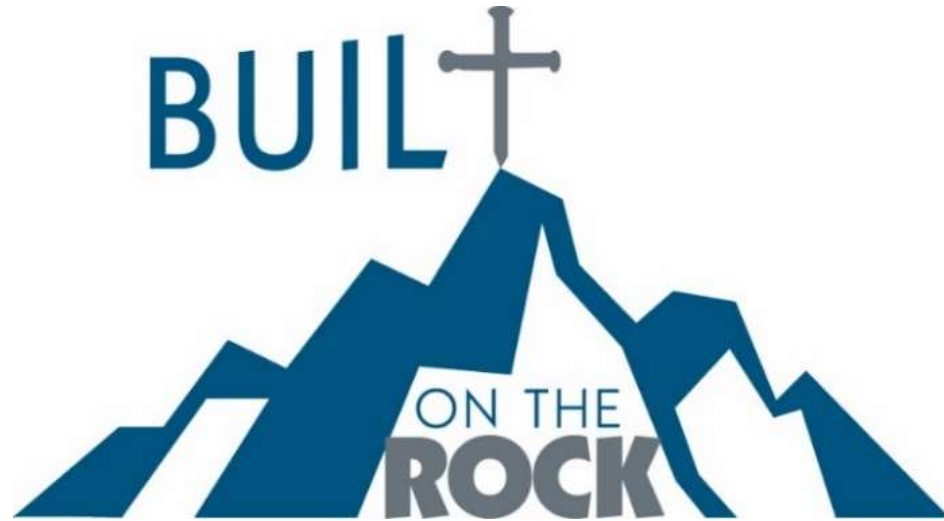

BUDGET NUMBERS UPDATED Both our preschool receipts (tuition) and our preschool expenditures (salaries) have been diverted from the General Fund to a separate fund to better track and understand the costs of operating the preschool. This has distorted the General fund data presented in the bulletin somewhat. To bring the data presented closer to reality the "Requirement to support unified budget" and "Overage (Shortfall)" have been adjusted to reflect this.
