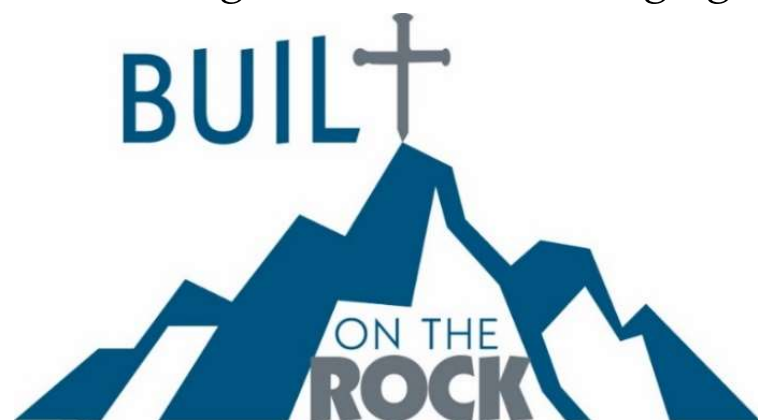

A year-ago at this time we had a deficit of \$97,220.02 versus a deficit of \$137,254.08 as of the end of June. Both years had 26 Sundays as of the end of June. Our total accumulated surplus at the beginning of the year was 13,287.28 which was reduced to -123,966.80 as of the end of June.

Other Notes: The deficit for the month was 24,761.71. This is almost identical to the deficit we had for the month of June in 2022. The contributed gifts are just slightly above those of last year (about \$2,400).
