A year-ago at this time we had a deficit of \$135,400.24 versus a deficit of \$78,236.55 as of the end of July. Both years had 31 Sundays as of the end of July. Our total accumulated surplus at the beginning of the year was 13,287.28 which was reduced to -64,949.27 as of the end of July. **Employee Retention Credit:** The Employee Retention Credit for wages paid during COVID in 2020 was applied for in March and received this month. The amount received for the second, third, and fourth quarters of 2020 totaled \$60,792.55. If we had not received this non-reoccurring receipt, our deficit would have been about 139,000 quite close to that of last year.
