A year-ago at this time we had a deficit of \$142,079.24 versus a deficit of \$87,784.74 as of the end of August. Both years had 35 Sundays as of the end of August. Our total accumulated surplus at the beginning of the year was 13,287.28 which was reduced to -74,497.46 as of the end of August. The Contributions are about 2.1% above those of last year.

Other Notes: **Tuition for the 2022-2023 School Year** - From 8/1/2022 through 7/31/2023, \$180,399.32 tuition dollars were received. Of that amount 37,287.50 was set aside for book purchases etc. and 9,251.47 was set aside for Chromebook purchases. That left 133,860.35 tuition dollars in the tuition fund. Of that amount 126,000 had been transferred to St. Peter's General Fund on a monthly basis (10,500 per month). The remaining 7,860.35 was transferred to the General Fund in August. This is reflected in the Other Receipts total above (166,023.75).
