

**PSALM OF THE DAY** *Read Responsively between Pastor and Congregation.* 

Bless the LORD, O my soul. All that is within me, bless his holy name. <sup>2</sup>Bless the LORD, O my soul, and do not forget all his benefits-<sup>3</sup>who pardons all your guilt, who heals all your diseases, <sup>4</sup>who redeems your life from the pit. who crowns you with mercy and compassion, <sup>5</sup>who satisfies your life with goodness, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle. <sup>6</sup>The LORD performs righteousness and justice for all the oppressed. <sup>7</sup>He made known his ways to Moses, his deeds to the people of Israel. <sup>8</sup>The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. <sup>9</sup>He will not always accuse. He will not keep his anger forever. <sup>10</sup>He does not treat us as our sins deserve. He does not repay us according to our guilty deeds. <sup>11</sup>Yes, as high as the heavens are above the earth, so powerful is his mercy toward those who fear him. <sup>12</sup>As distant as the east is from the west. so far has he removed our rebellious acts from us.

### LESSON

Daniel 6:6-10

<sup>6</sup>So these supervisors and satraps came as a group to the king and said this to him, "Darius, Your Majesty, may you live forever! <sup>7</sup>All the supervisors of the kingdom, the prefects and the satraps, the advisors and the governors advise the king to establish and enforce a decree that prohibits anyone to pray a prayer to any god or person for thirty days except to you, Your Majesty. Anyone who does so will be thrown into the den of lions. <sup>8</sup>Now Your Majesty, please establish the decree and sign a document that cannot be changed, according to the law of the Medes and the Persians that cannot be revoked."

<sup>9</sup>That is why King Darius signed the written decree.

<sup>10</sup>Now, when Daniel learned that the document had been signed, he went to his house. It had windows on its upper story that opened toward Jerusalem. Three times each day he would get on his knees and pray and offer praise before his God. He continued to do that, just as he had been doing before this.

## GOSPEL

#### Luke 17:11-19

<sup>11</sup>On another occasion, as Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem, he was passing along the border between Samaria and Galilee. <sup>12</sup>When he entered a certain village, ten men with leprosy met him. Standing at a distance, <sup>13</sup>they called out loudly, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

<sup>14</sup>When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." As they went away they were cleansed.

<sup>15</sup>One of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, glorifying God with a loud voice. <sup>16</sup>He fell on his face at Jesus' feet, thanking him. And he was a Samaritan. <sup>17</sup>Jesus responded, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? <sup>18</sup>Was no one found to return and give glory to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup>Then he said to him, "Get up and go your way. Your faith has saved you."
