A year-ago at this time we had a deficit of \$39,173.22 versus a 2024 deficit of \$68,108.45 as of the end of January. This year January had 4 Sundays versus 5 in 2023. This does create some inequity in the comparison. At the end of March, we will again have had an equal number of Sundays in both years. Our total accumulated deficit at the beginning of the year was 10.364.24 which was further increased to minus 78,472.69 by the January deficit.

Other notes:

- 1. St. Peter's Total Giving Receipts for 2023: The total giving for 2023 to all funds totaled 1,558,026 which was 1.4% above that of 2022.
- 2. Boiler Replacement: The total in the Improvement Fund received for boiler replacement as of the end of January is 59,596.
