**PASTOR'S SURGERY PLAN** This week Pastor is finishing up his last planned round of chemotherapy. His CT scan is February 28. He'll be having laparoscopic surgery on March 6 for the surgeon to see what the cancer looks like and make a plan for the big surgery, which is scheduled for April 3. During the big surgery (called HIPEC) the surgeon removes all cancerous tissue and then pumps liquid chemotherapy throughout the abdomen to directly target any remaining cancer cells. There will be a lengthy recovery in the hospital and at home, so your prayers are still appreciated.
