A year-ago at this time we had a deficit of \$74,096.63 versus a 2024 deficit of \$74,936.68 as of the end of February. This year had 8 Sundays versus 9 in 2023. At the end of March, we will have had an equal number of Sundays in both years. Lent began earlier this year than last which explains the difference in Special Services gifts. Our total accumulated deficit at the beginning of the year was 10,364.24 which was further increased to 85,300.92 by this year's deficit. February contributed 6,828.23 to the deficit.
