A year ago at this time we had a deficit of \$85,371.04 versus a 2024 deficit of \$37,747.73 as of the end of March. Both years had 13 Sundays. Lent began earlier this year than last which explains the difference in Special Services gifts which contain the Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter gifts this year. Our total accumulated deficit at the beginning of the year was \$10,364.24 which was increased to \$85, 300.92 by the end of February. The March surplus of \$37,188.95 reduced our Accumulated deficit to \$48, 111.97.

- 1. Focus on Energy: As a result of our new boiler installation, we participated in the Focus on Energy program and received \$24,648.82. This was deposited in the Improvement Fund and was applied to our boiler system payment.
- 2. LWMS: The door collection for LWMS totaled \$502.25.
- **3. Honoring the LORD:** In addition to our normal loan payment, the Honoring the LORD gifts reduced our facilities loan by an additional \$18,000 this month.
