**FORWARD IN CHRIST & MAY CALENDARS** The May issue of *Forward in Christ* is available in the narthex along with the May church calendars.

**GUEST PREACHER** for this weekend is Retired Pastor Jeff Berg. We thank him for bringing us God's Word.

**VOTERS' MEETING** The Coordinating Council is recommending that 3 full time pastors are still necessary. We will utilize a retired part time pastor to organize and minister the visitation/shut in ministry. The 3 areas the pastors will oversee are Inreach (Admin), Outreach/Adult Discipleship and School (School Board and Family Discipleship). The expected cost of a 3rd pastor is \$95,000. We recommend that our first call meeting will be October 27th, 2024.

The Coordinating Council is recommending hiring DuFrane Moving Company to move Pastor and Kris Lindemann at an expected cost of \$9,500. Donations and gifts are needed to support this move.

The Coordinating Council is recommending purchasing a new computer server. The cost of this replacement and installation is \$8,000.
