VOTERS' MEETING will take place **after the late service on Sunday.** The Coordinating Council is recommending that 3 full time pastors are still necessary. The 3 areas the pastors will oversee are Inreach (Admin), Outreach/Adult Discipleship and School (School Board and Family Discipleship). The expected cost of a 3rd pastor is \$95,000. We recommend that our first call meeting will be October 27th, 2024.

The Coordinating Council is recommending purchasing a new computer server. The cost of this replacement and installation is \$8,000.

MID-MAY HEALTH UPDATE This week brought another surprise in Pastor Boehringer's cancer story. This Monday Pastor and Sarah went down to Froedtert for a routine lab and clinic visit. (Pastor always gets blood work and has a face-toface visit with a member of his cancer team prior to getting a round of chemotherapy.) This was supposed to be his 13th and final round before taking a month-long break prior to his big surgery. However, this clinic visit led to testing to determine why Pastor had had fevers recently. In addition Pastor has had recurring leg pain. An ultrasound and CT scan followed and revealed blood clots in his leg and lungs. These findings (especially how many and where the clots are in his lungs) led his team to admit him to the hospital this past Monday evening and Tuesday out of an abundance of caution. He's home now, and on blood thinners, but his plans to be preaching and teaching this May have been altered. He had planned to preach this weekend, next weekend, and the first weekend in June, but now his team is advising him to reconsider some of these plans due to some of the risks of blood clots and blood thinners. He and Sarah will be talking with the cancer and surgery teams about how this might impact his surgery; as of right now, it's still on. So for

now please pray that the surgery can go forward, the clots clear up, nothing else unexpected happens, and that Pastor learns to let tomorrow worry about itself. If you have questions about his health situation, Pastor welcomes them (call/text 920-579-8150) and will give you answers if he has them.
