Hot Lunch Accounts: Just a reminder that negative lunch balances need to be taken care of **by May 31**. Positive balances can be carried over into the next school year. If you would like a refund of any positive balance, please let Mrs. Herbrand know (hotlunch@stpetersfdl.net). Any families that don't have a returning student can get a refund, if requested, or else any remaining balance will be put into the Student Aid Fund.

Closing Service: Our closing graduation service is **Thursday, May 23 at 6:30pm**. PreK – 7th grade will be singing and 8th graders will receive their diplomas. Report cards will be handed out **Friday, May 24** before the Noon release.

Summer Worship Schedule: May 26 is the start of our new summer worship schedule (Memorial – Labor Day weekends). Thursday service will remain at 6:30pm and Sunday will have one service at 9:00am.

Immunizations: Please have your child vaccinated well in advance of school starting, as it is often difficult to get clinic appointments if you wait until late summer. Call your provider, or the Fond du Lac County Health Department (929-3085) to check your child's immunization records.

For entry to kindergarten through seventh grades students need:

- 4 doses of polio vaccine
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 4 doses of DTaP/DTP/DT/TD
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox)*
- 2 doses of MMR
- 1 Tdap at seventh grade (was 6th grade)
- 1 MenACWY-containing vaccine at seventh grade (NEW)

Summer: Please watch your email over the summer for information regarding next school year.
