## On this rock I will build my Church



The Faith of our Fathers

And the immigrants kept coming.

Pastor Fachtmann was here for 8 months, October 1858 – July 10, 1859, all the while continuing his travels to other towns and cities. When he moved to La Crosse, fortunately, the congregation was vacant only two months. Churches had to wait for more pastors to be among the ever-increasing immigrant count.

St. Peter's first services were held in the County Court House and the Public School on Marr Street. These were available free of charge, bring your own firewood. The next location was the Presbyterian Church, services to be held immediately following theirs so the building would already be warm. Within two years, in 1860, the small congregation purchased the vacated Congregational Church which was used until 1869.

Pastor Boehner came next and served until early 1863. With the purchase of the building, the congregation's confidence in God's continued blessings persuaded them to invite synod to hold its 1860 convention here. This was a tremendous undertaking. Travel for attendees was challenging. And, as was the tradition well into the 1900's, attendees were housed, and fed, in the homes of members.

Wisconsin had become the 30<sup>th</sup> state in 1848. The new flag, with 30 stars was an official flag for only 3 years. By 1861, one by one, 4 more stars were added. The Civil War began April 12, 1861 when Confederate troops fired on Fort Sumter. The war raged for 4 bloody years. The population of the state was 775,000 persons over the age of 5. 91,000 of these, 12% of the population, served in the conflict including Wisconsin's famous Iron Brigade. Recruits were trained in four cities. Fond du Lac was one of those cities. The website of the Wisconsin Historical Society (wisconsinhistory.org) has much to offer the reader on this time period. Another item worth looking up is found at Time Magazine-History: "The Civil War was Won by Immigrant Soldiers."

God bless our native land! Firm may she ever stand through storm and night!

When the wild tempests rave, ruler of wind and wave,
